

# **2010 Washington Youth Tour**

## **Sponsored by the Gila River Indian Community Utility Authority**

The Gila River Indian Community Utility Authority (GRICUA) is looking for community-member, high-school students to participate in GRICUA's Youth Tour program. GRICUA will sponsor two students to Washington D.C. to participate in National Youth Tour week.

The Youth Tour, organized by the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association, brings over a thousand young people from across the United States to Washington D.C. to learn about community-owned electric utilities and the federal government. Additionally, students will tour historical sites and museums in the nation's capital.

### **Overview**

1. Tentative Youth Tour Dates: June 10-17, 2010
2. Students must be enrolled Gila River Indian Community members in their third year of high school (students may be home schooled through an accredited process).
3. Students will be required to submit responses to three essay questions. Each answer must be between 300-500 words. The top five students will be invited for an interview at GRICUA's office. The top two students will be selected for participation in the program.
